2013 Water Rate - \$4.05/1,000 gallons

2013 Base Rate - \$6.00/month/sfe*

Water System Development – **\$4,000 per** ¾**" s**FE Charge (SDC)

Owns, operates, and maintains approximately **78 miles** of water pipe (4"- 24")

Average, monthly residential water use – **8,750 gallons** Average, annual residential water use – **105,000 gallons** Water sold in 2012 – **920,117,000 gallons (2,823.7 acre feet)**

Gallons of water purchased in 2012 – **1,038,812,000** gallons (**3,187.9** acre feet)
