Water System

2014 Water Rate – \$4.20/1,000 gallons

2014 Base Rate – \$6.00/month/SFE*

Water System Development – \$4,000 per ¾" SFE Charge (SDC)

Owns, operates, and maintains approximately 78 miles of water pipe (4" - 24")

Average, monthly residential water use – 7,383 gallons

Average, annual residential water use – 88,590 gallons

Water sold in 2013 – 774,721,000 gallons (2,378 acre feet)

Gallons of water purchased in 2013 – 874,664,000 gallons (2,684 acre feet)

Master Meter Connections to Denver system – 18

Water valves in system – 1,311

Fire hydrants in system – 668

Largest user (customer) and gallons sold in 2013 – FCI (Federal Prison) 48,070,000 (148 acre feet)

*SFE – Single Family Equivalent – “a unit of measurement used to determine the capacity of water service required for a single family household”

Acre Foot – 325,851 gallons, enough water to cover one acre of surface area to a depth of one foot.

Sewer System

2014 Sewer Rate – \$21.10/month/SFE*

Sewer System Development Charge (SDC) – \$2,000 per SFE

Owns, operates, and maintains approximately 68 miles of sewer pipe (8 - 30")

There are approximately 1,769 manholes

Entire system is televised every four years and cleaned as needed.
